Honfleur Gallery presents ***The Eighth Annual East of the River*** exhibition this summer, highlighting the creative minds of Wards 7 and 8. Since the gallery opened in January 2007, this annual exhibit is always very well attended and received.

This year Honfleur Gallery is pleased to announce plans to focus *The Eighth Annual East of the River* exhibit with showing multiple pieces from up to five artists. Small grants will be provided to selected artists. (*Grants will be in the range of \$250-500.*)

The Eighth Annual East of the River exhibition is distinct from the East of the River Distinguished Artist Award and each program requires a separate application. If eligible, artists applying to *The Eighth Annual East of the River* exhibition are encouraged to apply for the East of the River Distinguished Artist Award. That application is available on the Honfleur Gallery website.

Who is eligible:

Visual artists who work in any media that live, work or who have roots in the areas East of the Anacostia River may submit 5-10 images for consideration. All submitted work samples must be available for exhibition. Emerging, mid career, and established artists all are encouraged to apply. Works created from January 2011-present will be accepted. Work shown previously at any Washington/Maryland/Virginia metro area gallery in 2014-2015 will not be accepted. Selected artists must be present for opening reception on July 10, 2015.

Notification: June 8, 2015

Art drop off (ready to hang): July 2, 2015

Exhibit opening: July 10, 2015 (required to attend opening if selected)

 - Image files need to be medium resolution jpeg files (150 dpi and no larger than 5x7 inches)
 - Image files must be labeled in this format: Applicant’sLastName.FirstName.#.jpg (example: Douglass.Frederick.1.jpg, Douglass.Frederick.2.jpg)
 - work created must be from January 2011-present
 - work shown previously at any Washington/Maryland/Virginia metro area gallery in 2014-2015 will not be accepted
