Second Quarter Report on Donations Approved by OCA for FY 2011

Pursuant to Mayor's Order 2010-167, dated October 15, 2010, the Office of the City Administrator (OCA), in consultation with the Office of the Attorney General's Ethics Counselor, is publishing the District's First Quarter Report on Donations for Fiscal Year 2011. The Order requires the OCA to review all requests by District officials to solicit or accept donations and approve or disapprove such requests as appropriate in accordance with the Rules of Conduct Governing Donations (Mayor Memorandum 2010-2) and D.C. Official Code Sec. 1-329.01 (2001).

This report includes data on all donation requests approved by the OCA for the period beginning January 1, 2011 and ending March 31, 2011. During this period, OCA approved the solicitation and/or acceptance of \$774,603.85 in donations of which \$177,930.00 represented financial contributions and \$596,673.85 were in-kind donations.
