The Fund for Community Art provides funds to visual artists to work on public works of art in their local communities.

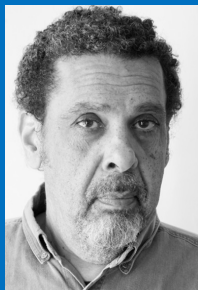

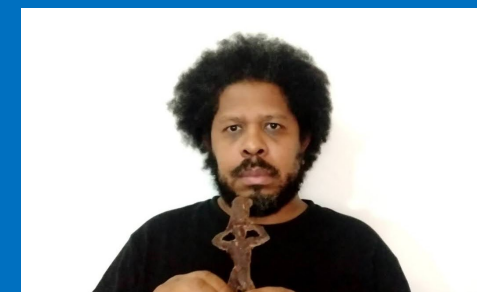

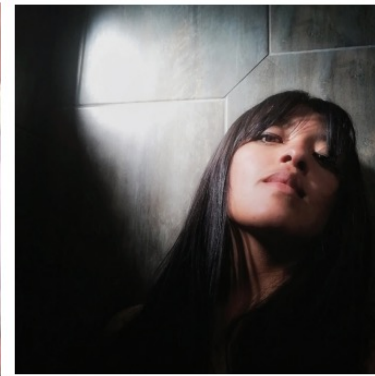
