

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:
Marion Barry, Jr. Legacy Mural Project
(4-12-22)

ARTWORK SPECIFICATIONS:

Q: Can the artwork for the mural be relief or contain sculptural elements? What is the maximum project from the wall? Would that change the load bearing capacity of the wall?

A: No. The specifications are as articulated in the RFQ page 4. "The mural must be attached to the existing marble cladding with load bearing of no more than 150lb/sf inclusive of artwork, framing and hanging supports and sized within the available wall space between the pillars. The artwork is to be at least 6' Away From Floor (AFF), with the following size parameters of the artwork: 26'x11'; 6'-AFF; 2'2" Below Finished Ceiling; 2' from each column". The artwork must be flat and may not exceed the depth of the framing system (2 to 5 inches).

Q: Can there be projection onto the wall as part of the mural? If so, what are the related parameters for projectors?

A: No, it is not possible to do projection art onto the wall dedicated for the mural
