Qualifications:

- Residents of the D.C. metropolitan area and surrounding areas
- Experience in the arts or humanities (artists, administrators, educators, gallery professionals, curators, critics)

Commitment:

- Review 25-30 applications (3-4 weeks)
- Participate in pre-panel review online (20-30 hours estimated)
- Attend online video conference panel meetings (unless otherwise noted)
- Payment of \$250 gift card at the end of the panel season

FY24 Grant Update:

We're happy to report significant progress on FY24 grant agreements. Here's a breakdown:

- 1054 out of 1198 grants (88%) have been fully executed.
- We've established 949 Purchase Orders (PO's), representing over 80% of our grantees.
