Twenty-three policies and eight investment recommendations focused on cultural creators, cultural consumers, and cultural spaces are presented in the DC Cultural Plan. Mayor Bowser's FY20 budget for CAH invests in several of these recommendations for first-year implementation of the Cultural Plan, including establishing a new Cultural Facilities Fund, a new Innovation and Entrepreneurship Loan Fund, a Public Space Security Fund, and a new Center for Cultural Opportunities to provide business development-related resources and trainings.
